Work with Children's Checks

School must verify the suitability of volunteers who will work with children including requiring all volunteers to provide evidence of their suitability. This evidence is generally a working with children check (WWC Check); however if a volunteer's occupation exempts them from the requirement to also have a WWC check e.g. police officers, teachers, they must provide evidence to support their claim to an exemption.

Working with Children checks can be done online and as a volunteer, these checks are free of charge. If you need assistance with these checks and applying please see Jaye on a Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday.
